

Routine Check-Up Guide

The following is an overview of the services your child may receive during their visit. Older girls may be more comfortable in gym shorts and sports bras, and may prefer to see Drs. Crigger or Schrodt or our nurse practitioners, Merideth Missi or Melissa Davidson. Likewise, older boys may be most comfortable in gym shorts, and may prefer to see Dr. Boel for their routine exams. Please bring any needed physical forms for school, sports, or daycare to their appointment, completing the parent portion in its entirety prior to the visit.

	5 year: Preventative care exam MMR & Varivax (ProQuad combo) if not given at 4yr. DTaP & IPV (Kinrix or Quadracel combo)	

****Pediarix (DTaP, IPV, Hep B) may be used instead of Pentacel at 2, 4, & 6 months.** If so, Hib vaccine will be given separately. **Kinrix or Quadracel** may be used instead of DPT and IPV separately at 5 yr. ProQuad may replace Varivax and MMR separately. Boostrix may replace Adacel at 11 yrs. Manufacturer supply may dictate availability. **Combo vaccines are highlighted.**

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
